- We need to prepare and plan in between weather events.
- We need to get on the county's 'Be Alert' program.
- We need a section on emergency preparedness and hazard mitigation in the master plan.
- We stocked up for a week-long scenario, It gets you through.
- We should talk to vulnerable people who don't have phones- to let them know how to access services.
- We need to let people know about the county emergency management team.
